- commit to supporting the District's and school's goal to improve student literacy, and be familiar with and knowledgeable about current literacy practices, including reading intervention strategies, assessment and evaluation techniques, best practices, and curriculum surrounding literacy;
- have the ability to respond to the learning needs of small groups of students, focusing on foundational, academic and social skills;
- have expertise in the use and applications of information technology;
- have experience incorporating Aboriginal language and culture throughout the curriculum;
- possess expertise with literacy development and the ability to meet diverse learning needs, by innovating and incorporating new ideas;
- support an inclusive model for Special Needs students by implementing Individualized Education Plans with colleagues and parents;
- create effective intervention strategies for students who require support and assistance with their behaviour and learning;
- demonstrate skills and commitment to building rapport with students;
- supervise Special Needs Education Assistants who may be assigned;
- engage parents, teachers and support staff in the development and review of a plan that is suited to the needs of the child;
