Regulation

1. The District Parents' Advisory Council, in consultation with the Superintendent of Schools/Secretary-Treasurer, shall make bylaws governing its meetings and the business and conduct of its affairs, including bylaws governing the dissolution of the Council.
2. The District Parents' Advisory Council is to comprise of persons representing Parents' Advisory Councils within the District.
3. The District Parents' Advisory Council must elect officers according to established bylaws.
4. The District Parents' Advisory Council, through its elected officers, may advise the Board and the Superintendent of Schools/Secretary-Treasurer on any matter relating to the School District.
5. The Board of Education may resolve once annually to allocate operating funds to the District Parents' Advisory Council. The funds can be designated for specific purposes. The elected officers of the District Parents' Advisory Council will account to the Board of Education as to the dispersal of those funds.
6. No new funding will be allocated until the officers of the District Parents' Advisory Council render an accounting to the Board of Education.
7. It is the intent of the funding to support the activities of the District Parents' Advisory Council. The District Parents' Advisory Council may reallocate funds to properly constituted school Parents' Advisory Councils so as to enable a more effective functioning of such local school councils.
