### Policy

The Board of Education sanctions the use of District facilities for student clubs and activities. Such clubs and activities need not be directly related to school educational programs but cannot be detrimental to the objectives, goals or standards of the school or community.

# REGULATION

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### Regulation

1. The Principals must approve all clubs or activities that use school facilities. The Superintendent of Schools/Secretary-Treasurer will do so if the Principal is not available or the location is the School Board Office. The Principals or Superintendent of Schools/ Secretary-Treasurer will specify the conditions whereby the club or activity will operate.
2. The Principal or Superintendent of Schools/Secretary-Treasurer is expected to seek the guidance of the Board of Education or a Parents' Advisory Council when such guidance could help to determine the appropriateness of the club or activity in the facilities. Such guidance will be sought when the club or activity has religion or politics as the focus of interest.
3. The decision of the Principal or Superintendent of Schools/Secretary-Treasurer to sanction, or not to sanction, any student or community club or activity can be appealed to the Board of Education.
