Policy

The Board of Education is committed to the advancement of student education by direct or indirect means. That commitment includes helping students achieve long-term educational goals which extend beyond the secondary program. That support will be provided, when possible, to students by means of work experience and income. The purpose of the work experience is to develop the aptitudes and skills needed for future successes in a chosen career. The purpose of the work income is for securing some of the economic means to post-secondary education.

REGULATION

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Regulation

The Board of Education will make an effort to provide some temporary employment to suitable students. Given the limited number of student employment opportunities, such opportunities will be distributed as equitably as possible among suitable candidates. Preference will be given but not limited to current or former students of the School District.

The obligations of a student seeking temporary employment are:

- submission of a letter of application, resume and references for a student employment posting;
- graduation from secondary school or completion of at least one year at a recognized post-secondary institution and demonstration of good academic standing;
- evidence that studies will be continued at a recognized educational institution; and,
- an acceptance of the condition that the student employment posting for a particular student will usually be limited to one posting, so as to enable a sharing of the opportunity among deserving students over a period of years.
