Policy

It is the policy of the Board that if a school receives a bomb threat during school hours, the school will be evacuated, and as little publicity as possible will be given to the event.

Regulation

1. On receipt of a bomb threat, the Principal or Teacher In Charge will immediately:
 - call 911;
 - conduct a visual check of all exits to ensure exits are safe;
 - ring the fire alarm and evacuate the school.
2. Students will not be permitted to re-enter the school until the police, or the Principal or the Teacher In Charge, have determined that it is safe to do so.
3. The procedure should be treated as a fire drill, and if possible, children should not be informed otherwise.
