

## **BOMB THREATS**

It is the policy of the School District that if a school receives a bomb threat during school hours, the school will be evacuated and as little publicity as possible will be given to the event.

1. On receipt of a bomb threat, the School Principal or Teacher In Charge will immediately:
  - call 911;
  - conduct a visual check of all exits to ensure exits are safe;
  - ring the fire alarm and evacuate the school.
2. Students will not be permitted to re-enter the school until the police, or the School Principal or the Teacher In Charge, have determined that it is safe to do so.
3. The procedure should be treated as a fire drill, and if possible, children should not be informed otherwise.
