

ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The School District supports the attendance of international students in its school system for social, cultural and educational reasons.

An international student is a student who is not ordinarily resident in the School District and/or the student's guardian is not ordinarily resident in British Columbia.

Tuition fees shall be set by the Secretary-Treasurer (or designate) and paid by international students registering in School District schools, unless waived by the Secretary-Treasurer (or designate).

International students shall be eligible to register in School District schools if the Superintendent (or designate) approves the registration and there is space available.

The School District is not responsible for costs associated with travel arrangements, accommodation or medical expenses of international students.

School placement of international students within the School District shall be determined by the School Principal of the receiving school after consultation with the Superintendent and Secretary-Treasurer (or designates).
